GENERAL INFORMATION

The papers and articles to be published may cover and disseminate research topics, projects, experiences, protocols and/or knowledge about the situation of **school nursing** in the country of residence of each author or authors.

As a general rule, all papers submitted must be original, of high quality, free of plagiarism and in accordance with the scientific standards for publication detailed in this document.

PAPER TYPES



RESEARCH

Papers related to quantitative and/or qualitative methodology, which aims to describe a nursing research activity related to the health care of children and adolescents in educational centers and their community.

Contents: Introduction, objectives, material and methods used in the research, methodology, discussion and analysis, conclusions and bibliography.

Bibliographical-narrative research papers may be submitted, in which case the content will be: Introduction, theoretical framework, research objectives, methodology, construction of information, analysis of narrative results, challenges and scope of narrative research, results, conclusions and bibliography.



CONCEPTUAL RESEARCH

Papers that refer to the theoretical framework in the development of nursing work in schools and educational communities.

Contents: Introduction, development of the subject to be analyzed, discussion, conclusions and bibliography.



SCHOOL NURSING PROJECTS & EXPERIENCES

Refers to papers whose aim is to communicate projects or experiences of nursing practice in schools and their educational community, which contain innovative and relevant components for the practice of the profession.

Contents: Introduction, development of the experience and conclusions, bibliography used by the authors.

PAPER TYPES



SCHOOL NURSING CLINICAL CASES

Papers related to the clinical practice of nurses in one of their different areas of care.

Contents: Introduction, description of the different elements of the nursing process and development, conclusions, discussions and bibliography.



LITERATURE REVIEW

Analysis, comparison and interpretation of specific references of existing literature about school nurses and their professional roles and competences.

Contents: Introduction, presentation of the subject analyzed, conclusions and bibliography.

ASSESSMENT

The Editorial Board will evaluate each and every article/paper received. The committee will take into account the fulfilment of the requirements set for the publication of articles. It will also decide which articles will be published and in which issue it deems appropriate. Authorship of works will be respected and they will be subject to the applicable copyright laws.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING ARTICLES

- Language: Texts in Spanish, English, Portuguese and French will be accepted. The article will be published in the language in which it was received.
- **Translation:** Each article must be submitted with the English translation of the title, subtitle (if any), abstract and keywords.
- **Number of words:** The text of each paper should be a minimum of 1,200 words and a maximum of 2,500 words. Each paper should be accompanied by an abstract of no more than 250 words (excluding the bibliography).
- **Number of authors:** It is recommended that the number of authors should not exceed 6. If this number is exceeded, a note explaining the reason and necessity for this must be submitted.
- Title: The title of each paper should not exceed 20 words.
- **Keywords:** Include 5 keywords immediately after the abstract of the paper.
- Bibliography: A maximum of 10 main bibliographical references should be included.
- Characteristics of the document: 1.5 spacing, Calibri or Arial font, size 12, NO numbered pages and NO headings. You may include 4 statistical tables or 2 figures, depending on the work submitted. We recommend that all images be sent as attached files to preserve their quality.

SUBMISSION

Articles should be submitted in a Word document to <u>isna.schoolnurses@gmail.com</u>, specifying "Article publishing" as email subject.
